 - Supports the preschool team
 - Social Worker 7 hour work day / student school day is
 6.5 hours
 - Factors:
 - Responding to immediate student needs,
 - Travel time within district
 - Students' schedules, testing
 - Meetings with parents
 - Social history assessments
 - Meetings with outside service providers
