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Minutes of School Committee Meeting 04/01/2016

A meeting of the Barrington School Committee was held on Friday, April 1, 2016 in the Barrington High School Conference Room. School Committee Chair Kate Brody called the meeting to order at 7:15 a.m. Present were Mrs. Brody, Mr. Alessandro, Mrs. Clancy, Mr. Guida, and Director of Administration and Finance Mr. Ronald D. Tarro. Absent was Dr. Shea.

New Business from Superintendent and Staff

Mr. Tarro provided the Committee with a bid tabulation document for Internet Services in conjunction with the eRate application process for FY 2016-2017. It is the recommendation of the Administration, based on the Technology Department's evaluation, that the bid be awarded to the lowest qualified evaluated bidder, OSHEAN, North Kingstown, Rhode Island at an annual cost of \$19,760 before the eRate discount.

Mr. Guida moved and Mr. Alessandro seconded to award the bid for Internet Services to the lowest qualified evaluated bidder, OSHEAN, of North Kingstown, Rhode Island, at an annual cost of \$19,760 before the eRate discount. The motion passed 4-0 with Mrs. Brody, Mr. Alessandro, Mrs. Clancy, and Mr. Guida voting in the affirmative for the motion.

Mr. Guida moved and Mrs. Clancy seconded to adjourn the open meeting at 7:21 a.m. and go into Executive Session pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws Section 42-46-5(a)(2) for work sessions pertaining to collective bargaining or litigation with National Education Association Barrington (NEAB) and United Steelworkers. The motion passed 4-0 with Mrs. Brody, Mr. Alessandro, Mrs. Clancy, and Mr. Guida voting in the affirmative for the motion.
