

Minutes of School Committee Meeting 12/21/2015

A meeting of the Barrington School Committee was held on Monday, December 21, 2015, in the Administration Building. School Committee Chair Kate Brody called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. Present were Mrs. Brody, Dr. Shea, Mr. Alessandro, Mr. Guida, and Mr. Messoro.

Mrs. Brody introduced the Committee, read the relevant Rhode Island General Law, stated that the individual to be discussed has been so notified and advised in writing and that since no request to hold the discussion at an open meeting was received, the meeting would be held in Executive Session.

Dr. Shea moved and Mr. Guida seconded to adjourn into Executive Session pursuant to Rhode Island General Law 42-46-5(a)(1) for discussion of job performance relating to an appeal by an administrator regarding evaluation. The motion passed 4-0 with Mrs. Brody, Dr. Shea, Mr. Alessandro, and Mr. Guida voting in the affirmative for the motion.

Dr. Shea moved and Mr. Guida seconded to adjourn the Executive Session at 8:30 p.m. and to seal the minutes. The motion passed 4-0 with Mrs. Brody, Dr. Shea, Mr. Alessandro, and Mr. Guida voting in the affirmative for the motion.

Dr. Shea moved and Mr. Guida seconded to return to open session at 8:31 p.m. The motion passed 4-0 with Mrs. Brody, Dr. Shea, Mr. Alessandro, and Mr. Guida voting in the affirmative for the motion.

Dr. Shea moved and Mr. Guida seconded that the School Committee is satisfied that the Superintendent has conducted a complete review both of the employee evaluation and the employee's rebuttal, and the School Committee declines to engage in any further review of the Superintendent's decision as such intervention would be contrary to statutorily defined duties of the School Committee and Superintendent respectively in Rhode Island General Laws 16-2-9 and 16-2-11. The motion passed 4-0 with Mrs. Brody, Dr. Shea, Mr. Alessandro, and Mr. Guida voting in the affirmative for the motion.
